Europlan Foundation to continue the role of Europlan Nederland

The Europlan Nederland Foundation was established on 23 November 2015. Starting next year, this foundation will continue the work of the Europlan Nederland Foundation for the international Europan competition in a contemporary context. With this move, Europlan Nederland is transferring all tasks and authority to Europlan Nederland with effect from January 1, 2016. Europlan Nederland has applied for membership of the international organization Europan Europe on behalf of the Netherlands.

This change is the result of a study carried out by [Architectuur Lokaal](#) and [Europlan Nederland](#). The central issue in discussions conducted with numerous experts concerned pursuing a meaningful course in a present-day context, which is seeing the role of designers undergoing great change in terms of their relation with clients and the nature of commissions. The main aim remains to promote young architects, urban planners and landscape architects and enhance their chances to commissions.

The involvement of Architectuur Lokaal ensures continuity for Europan and Europlan. The board of Europlan Nederland is made up of Thérèse van Schie (chairwoman), Jeroen de Willigen (from Europlan Nederland) and Thijs Asselbergs (on behalf of Architectuur Lokaal). Responsibility for coordinating the daily affairs lies with Indira van 't Klooster, senior project manager at Architectuur Lokaal and editor-in-chief of *A10 new European architecture*.
